Secure Media Destruction

Your most secure, cost-effective disposal alternative.

Incineration is the only disposal technique that allows for total destruction of media – and total peace of mind. MCP Secure Media Destruction gives you the highest level of confidence, and respect for the environment, at a cost that is less than a traditional degaussing and landfill disposal solution. To document data security, we'll provide you with a Certificate of Destruction upon job completion to verify the combustion and disposal of your media.

For additional data security requirements, MCP offers several enhanced security options including:

Sealed Truck Transportation

A sealed truck can be provided to securely transport media from your site to the incineration facility.

Degaussing

For the absolute highest level of data security, media can be degaussed at your site, or our site, and then transported for incineration.

Witness Participation

A witness from the incinerator site or from an independent security firm can be engaged to verify that media entered the combustion unit as contracted and documented.

A process approach that guarantees your data integrity

- Step 1. **Request for service.** We'll work with you to identify the quantities and types of media to be disposed, as well as the level of security your data requires.
- Step 2. **Price quote.** MCP Secure Media Destruction costs are based on four variables: estimated weight of media to be disposed; distance from the waste-to-energy facility; required level of security, and if media is to be degaussed before destruction.
- Step 3. **Transportation.** Pick up and delivery will be scheduled in accordance with your security needs and timeframe. For example in most cases, we can pick up media at your facility with 48 hours of your request.
- Step 4. **Destruction of media.** The approved media load will be incinerated within 24 hours of arrival at the waste-to-energy facility. Shipments are never warehoused or stored.
- Step 5. **Confirmation.** A certificate of Destruction is issued, confirming completion of the job.
